Curriculum Goals and Objectives

Social-Emotional Development

Goal: To learn about self and others

- Trusts known, caring adults
- Regulates own behavior
- Manages own feelings
- Responds to others' feelings with growing empathy
- Develops an understanding of and an appreciation for his/her uniqueness in the world
- Plays with other children
- Learns to be a member of a group
- Uses personal care skills

Physical Development

Goal: To learn about moving

- Develop large muscle strength to move within the environment
- Develop small muscle strength and control for detailed exploration and manipulation of objects



Cognitive Development

Goal: To learn about the world

- Sustains attention
- Understands how objects can be used
- Shows a beginning understanding of cause and effect
- Shows a beginning understanding that things can be grouped
- Uses problem-solving strategies
- Engages in pretend play
- Able to mirror, repeat and practice actions modeled by another
- Understands how things move and fit in space

Language Development

Goal: To learn about communicating

- Develops receptive language (understands others)
- Develops expressive language (communicates with others)
- Participates in conversations
- Enjoys books and being read to
- Shows an awareness of pictures and print
- Experiments with drawing and writing
